INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. INTRODUCTION

Maharashtra State Khadi & Village Industries Board (MSKVIB, A Government of Maharashtra, established in 1961, Located at 19/21, Manohardas Street, fort, Mumbai 400001 with an objective to promote khadi and village industries in the state of Maharashtra invites proposals from manufactures/authorized suppliers SUPPLY OF BEE COLONIES APIS CERANA INDICA BEE COLOIES 6 COMBS WITH FRAME FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE BENEFICIARIES AND SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ALL OVER MAHARASHTRA.

2. DEFINITIONS

“Applicable Law” means all relevant laws in force and effect as of the date hereof, and which may be promulgated or brought into force and effect hereafter in India, including judgments, decrees, injunctions, writs, or orders of any court, as may be in force and effect during the subsistence of this Tender Document.

“Bid Document” shall mean the document submitted by the Bidder pursuant to its understanding of, and agreement with, the terms and conditions set out in this Tender Document.

“Contract” shall mean the sale agreement to be entered into between MSKVIB and the Successful Bidder.

“MSKVIB” shall mean the Maharashtra State Khadi and Village Industries Board constituted under the provisions of the Bombay Khadi and Village Industries Act, 1960.

“CEO, MSKVIB” shall mean the Chief Executive Officer of the Maharashtra State Khadi and Village Industries Board constituted under the provisions of the Bombay Khadi and Village Industries Act, 1960.

“Evaluation Committee” shall mean the committee constituted by the CEO, MSKVIB to evaluate the Tender Documents. **“Force Majeure Event”** shall have the meaning assigned to it in Clause 2.5.

“Project” shall mean the entire process, including issuance of the Bid, selection of the appropriate Bidder, placement of order for the supply of **BEE COLONIES (APIS CERANA INDICA), DISTRIBUTION TO BENEFICIARIES, and SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ACROSS MAHARASHTRA.**

“BEE COLONIES” shall mean the material required for the **SUPPLY OF BEE COLONIES (APIS CERANA INDICA), CONSISTING OF 6-COMB COLONIES, FOR DISTRIBUTION TO BENEFICIARIES AND FOR SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ACROSS MAHARASHTRA,** as specified in the Annexure enclosed with the Bid Document.

In this tender document, unless the context otherwise requires,

- a) For the purpose of this tender Document, where the context so admits,
 - i) The singular shall be deemed to include the plural and vice-versa, and
 - ii) Masculine gender shall be deemed to include the feminine gender and vice-versa.
- b) References to a “person” if any shall, where the context so admits, include references to natural persons, partnership firms, companies, bodies corporate and associations, whether incorporated or not or any other organization or entity including any government or political subdivision, ministry, department or agency thereof;
- c) References to clauses, recitals or schedules are references to clauses and recitals of and schedules to the contract and the Tender Document. The Schedules, annexure and addendums shall form an integral part of this contract.
- d) Any reference herein to a statutory provision shall include such provision, as is in force for the time being and as from time to time, amended or re-enacted in so far as such amendment or re-enactment is capable of applying to any transactions covered by this contract. Any references to an enactment include references to any subordinate legislation made under that enactment and any amendment to, or replacement of, that enactment or subordinate legislation. 5. INVITATION FOR BIDS

This “invitation for bids” is for-supply of **BEE COLONIES (APIS CERANA INDICA 6 combs with frame) AND OTHER EQUIPMENTS, FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE BENEFICIARIES AND SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ALL OVER MAHARASHTRA**

6. DUE DILIGENCE

The Bidder is expected to, and shall be deemed to have, examined all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications contained in this Tender Document. The Bid should be precise, complete, and in the prescribed format as per the requirements of the Tender Document. Failure to furnish all information required by the Tender Document, or submission of a Bid that is not responsive to the Tender Document in every respect, shall be at the Bidder’s risk and may result in rejection of the Bid. The CEO, MSKVIB shall, at its sole discretion, be entitled to determine the adequacy or sufficiency of the information provided by the Bidder.

7. COST OF BIDDING

The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and CEO, MSKVIB shall in no event or circumstance be held responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

8. CLARIFICATION OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

CEO, MSKVIB shall make best efforts to respond to written request by the prospective bidder for clarification, if any, on the tender document.

9. AMENDMENT OF TENDER DOCUMENT

At any time before the deadline for submission of bids, CEO, MSKVIB may, for any reason whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the Tender Document by amending modifying its terms and conditions and/or supplementing the same. All changes shall be posted on website of <http://mahatenders.gov.in> and prospective Bidders are required to go through the same before submission of bid. All such amendments shall be binding them without any further act or deed on CEO, MSKVIB’s part. In the event of any amendment, CEO, MSKVIB reserves the right to extend the deadline for the submission of the bids, in order to allow prospective bidders reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account while preparing their bids.

10. LANGUAGE OF BID

The Bid prepared by the Bidder, as well as all correspondences and documents relating to the tender Document and/or the bidding process exchanged by the Bidder and CEO, MSKVIB shall be written in English language only.

11. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Bidders are requested to read the tender document thoroughly.

11.1. Bidder is one who has responded to the bid for supply **OF BEE COLONIES APIS CERANA INDICA 6 combs with frame required FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE BENEFICIARIES AND SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ALL OVER MAHARASHTRA.**

11.2. In the event of any additional information required by the CEO, MSKVIB other than that specified in the per-qualification criteria, the Bidder to the CEO, MSKVIB shall duly submit such information in the prescribed time. The Bidder shall submit the tender document duly signed on each page as a part of the bid. It shall be expressly agreed herein by the bidder that he has read and understood the complete tender Document and other documents/ requirements and shall comply with the same expect what is stated in specified Deviation/ Non-Compliance statement format.

11.3. Bids received with incomplete information/document shall be rejected. Bids not adhering to terms Conditions, Specification and other details as given in this document may be summarily rejected.

11.4. This tender document is not transferable.

11.5. Modification or withdrawal of Offers is not permissible after its submission. If the offer is withdrawn before the validity period indicated in Para 18.1 the EMD will stand forfeited assist in the scrutiny, evaluation and comparison of offers, CEO, MSKVIB may ask some or all Bidders for clarification on some of the points of their offer. The bidder shall provide the necessary clarification within the stipulated time schedule.

11.6. **Preliminary scrutiny:** CEO, MSKVIB will scrutinize the offers to determine whether they are complete, whether any errors have been made in the offer, whether required technical documentation has been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed and whether items are quoted as per the schedule CEO, "CEO, MSKVIB" may, at its discretion, waive any minor non-conformity or any minor irregularity in an offer. This shall be binding on all Bidders and CEO, MSKVIB reserves the right for such waivers.

11.7. Bidders should not have been barred and violated any terms and conditions including supply OF APIS CERANA INDICA BEE COLOIES 6 COMBS WITH FRAME FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE BENEFICIARIES AND SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ALL OVER MAHARASHTRA

11.8. **Award Criteria:** Technical Offers in Envelope 1 will be evaluated first to check whether all required information and document as specified In the Tender Document are submitted and to ascertain whether the Bidder meets all Qualifying Criteria. The Bidders who's Technical Office are found to be in accordance with the specifications mentioned in the tender document would be short-listed and only their Commercial Bids in Envelope 2 would be opened.

11.9 The Bidder should abide by the terms and conditions specified in the tender document. If Bidders submit conditional offers, they shall be liable for outright rejection The CEO MSKVIB shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other offer received in response to this tender notice and shall be entitled to reject any or all offers including those received late or incomplete offers without assigning any reason whatsoever. The

CEO, MSKVIB reserves the right to make any changes in the terms and conditions of the tender prior to the last date of submission by publishing the changes on the site of <http://mahatenders.gov.in>.

The offers containing erasures or alterations will not be considered. Technical details must be completely filled in. Correct technical information of the service being offered must be filled in. Filling up of the information using terms such as “ok” accepted”. Noted. “As given in brochure I manual “is not acceptable. CEO, MSKVIB may treat offers not adhering to these guidelines as unacceptable. Bidders are not allowed to subcontract in any manner without written approval from CEO, MSKVIB.

12. QUALIFICATION CRITERIA OF THE BIDDER

12.1. Bidder should have the capacity of the supply of Apis cerana Indica bee colonies as per the demand of MSVKIB.

12.2. The bidder should have the trained personal/skilled manpower in the skill of Bee breeding.

12.3. The bidder should have its own Apiaries of Apis cerana Indica bee colonies.

12.4. He should have to show the Apiary site of Apis cerana Indica bee colonies to the officials of MSVKIB at the time of visit to the Apiary.

12.5. Bidder can be a proprietary or Partnership Firm or Pvt. Ltd. Or social charity trust or limited company or registered society. Or MSKVIB or KVIC registered unit, or progressive beekeeper trained under the Beekeeping programme of MSKVIB or NBHM Honey village.

12.6. The Bidder should have capacity to supply the bee colonies in cost with their own manpower.

12.7. The bidder should have technical personnel for installation and Setting up of Bee units at the places of beneficiaries and nursery sites of

12.8. Their should be abided to provide services time to time for setting up of Bee Nursery and Bee breeding, inspection of Bee Nursery/ bee colonies supplied to the beekeepers well as Nurseries Of Honey village least six month .

12.9. Bidder should have GST, TAN, PAN, Udyog Adhar, etc.

12.10. The Bidder have at least Five years' experience in the Beekeeping and at least one year experience for supplying bee colonies, breeding etc.

12.11. Bidders may be members of the National Bee Board (NBB).

12.12. The minimum annual sale of Bee Colonies shall be Rs. 5.00 lakhs.

13. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

13.1 Bidders are required to pay Rs.3000/- (Rs. Three Thousand only) towards processing fee in the form of DD of nationalized bank/ Bank order drawn in favors of “**Maharashtra state khadi & village industries board**” payable at Mumbai the processing fee is non-refundable.

13.2 The bidder should also pay Rs. 50000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only) as earnest money deposit (EMD) for the bids in from of Demand Draft/pay order of Nationalized bank drawn in favour of Maharashtra State Khadi & Village Industries Board' payable at Mumbai.”

13.3 Processing fee & EMD Demand Drafts/pay orders receipt of payment of processing fee should be part of Envelope - 1.

13.4 The EMD is non-interest bearing and is refundable to unsuccessful bidders after signing of the contract by the successful bidder.

13.5 The EMD of successful bidders will be released upon expiry of “offer Validity Period” as mentioned in instruction to Bidder EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded after one month of finalization of tender.

13.6 The EMD will be forfeited. If a bidder withdraws his bid during the period of validity or in case of a successful bidder, if the Bidder fails.

- a) To sign the contract in accordance with terms and conditions.
- b) To furnish Bid security as specified in terms and conditions.

14. OVERALL EVALUATION METHODOLOGY

14.1. CEO, MSKVIB shall evaluate and compare the bids determined to be Substantially Responsive. Any effort made by the Bidder to influence officials of CEO, MSKVIB in the evaluation/contract award decision, may result in the rejection of the Bidder’s bid. It is CEO, MSKVIB’s intent to select the bid that is most advantageous to CEO, MSKVIB and each Bid will be evaluated using the criteria and process outlined below. The CEO, MSKVIB reserves right to reject any or all bids without assigning any reasons.

14.2. Bidder should bring the sample of teak wood brood frames, photographs and video clips of his own Apiaries of Apis cerana Indica bee colonies per the specification mentioned in Annexure before the Technical Evaluation Committee for inspection at the time of technical bid opening. The Technical and Commercial evaluation of Bids shall be carried out by the CEO, MSKVIB. Only those commercial Bids who qualify in the technical evaluation shall be considered.

14.3. The Commercial Bid (which is technically qualified) with the lowest offer will be eligible for further negotiations with CEO, MSKVB.

15. EVALUATION OF BIDS

15.1. The Bidding process shall be a two-stage process. Prior to the detailed evaluation of the Technical Bids, CEO, MSKVIB shall determine whether each bid is (a) complete (b) is accompanied by the required information and document and (c) is substantially responsive to the requirements set forth in the tender document. A substantially responsive Bid is one, which conforms to the requirements, terms, conditions and specifications of the Tender without any deviation. CEO, MSKVIB, evaluation in this regard shall be final and binding on all Bidders.

15.2. Based on the results of the Technical evaluation, CEO, MSKVIB shall then proceed to Open and evaluate the Commercial Bid of those Bidders who qualify in the Technical Evaluation. The Commercial evolution will take into account the information supplied. By the Bidders in the Commercial Bid and the same shall be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation criteria specified in the tender document.

15.3. CEO, MSKVIB may at its sole discretion, waive any minor infirmity or non-conformity of irregularity in a Bid Document, which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such a waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.

16. Tender Evaluation Committee

The CEO, MSKVIB will constitute the Tender Evaluation Committee. This committee will evaluate the Bid Document submitted by the Bidders. The Tender Evaluation

Committee may choose to conduct technical negotiation or discussion with any or all the Bidders. The decision of the Evaluation committee in the evaluation of the Technical and commercial bids shall be final and binding on all the parties. Any effort by a Bidder to influence the member of Tender Evaluation Committee during processing of Bids, may result in the rejection of Bid.

17. UNDERTAKING

An undertaking from the Bidder stating the compliance with all the condition of the contract and Technical Specification of the Bidding Document will be required since no deviation will be acceptable to CEO, MSKVIB

18. BID PRICE

18.1. The commercial offer must be made by the intending Bidder, covering all important points mentioned in the bid format enclosed in this Bid Document. The commercial offer may be submitted keeping in view the terms and conditions of this Bid Document and the site conditions.

18.2. The bidder shall include payment of all dues such as excise, taxes, packing forwarding charges, freight charges, insurance charges, installations/ trial and commissioning, demonstration etc., not specifically mentioned in the specification but essential for supply **OF BEE COLONIES (APIS CERANA INDICA) FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE BENEFICIARIES AND SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ALL OVER MAHARASHTRA.**

18.3. The bidder shall not be eligible for any extra charges in respect of such payment. Though not mentioned in the bid document, any other applicable taxes/duties shall be paid by the bidder only.

18.4. All liabilities, whatsoever, on account of variations in Govt.Policy or any other reason, if any shall be borne by the bidder, during the tenure of the contract.

18.5. Any royalties or patents or the charges for the use of infringement thereof might involve in the contract shall not be paid by CEO, MSKVIB. The bidder only shall pay for such claims without putting any financial burden on MSKVIB.

19. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS

19.1 VALIDITY PERIOD

Bids shall remain valid for Two years after the date of bid opening prescribed by CEO, MSKVIB. CEO, MSKVIB hold the right to reject a bid valid for a period shorter than Three years as non-responsive, without any correspondence.

19.2 Extension of period of Validity

In Exceptional circumstances, CEO, MSKVIB may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity shall be unconditional. The EMD provided validity shall also be suitably extended. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting the EMD. A Bidder granting extension of validity will not be permitted to modify his technical extension of validity will not be permitted to modify his technical or commercial bid.

SECTION- 2

TENDER AND CONDITIONS AND SCOPE OF WORK

2.1 Supply terms

- a) Apis cerana Indica bee colonies to be supplied to MSKVIB should be as per specifications given in Tender and as per the supply order of MSVKIB.
- b) Successful bidder need to submit certificate/authenticity report of SUPPLY OF BEE COLONIES APIS CERANA INDICA BEE COLOIES 6 COMBS FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE BENEFICIARIES AND SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ALL OVER MAHARASHTRA
- c) Successful bidder should give delivery of all bee colonies at the locations identified by the MSKVIB against the supply order of MSVKIB to the officer authorized by CEO, MSKVIB. The bidder also deposes his representative along with equipment's for installation.

No additional charges will be paid for packing forwarding, freight, Insurance, installation/trial commissioning/demonstration and for visit of officials.

- d) Any damage caused to equipment / material during transportation shall be the sole Responsibility of bidder.CEO, MSKVIB will not be responsible for such damages.
- e) No advance will be paid against the issuance of order.
- f) Delivery beyond the stipulated period of delivery schedule will attract penalty decided by the MSKVIB Authority.
- g) The C.E.O.MSKVIB will send the letter of award to the successful bidder online and by post. The Successful bidder should acknowledge the receipt of the order online to the CEO, MSKVIB by letter sent by Register post A.D.
- h) If the successful bidder fails to supply the bee colonies within the stipulates period and according to terms and conditions of this tender or fails to replace rejected bee colonies within such time as may be stipulated by CEO,MSKVIB, then CEO,MSKVIB., shall be entitled to purchase such bee colonies of Apis cerana Indica from any other sources. The extra expenditure in such cases shall be recovered from the successful bidder by CEO, MSKVIB from the outstanding bill of successful bidder, if no bill of successful bidder are outstanding with CEO, MSKVIB then extra expenditure shall be recovered from the Security Deposit.
- i) The successful bidder has to supply (only) teak wood six frame bee colonies with comb. Honey bees on six combs and brood on Three to Four combs, the remaining frames should have nectar and pollen.
- ii) He has to transport the bee colonies from his own box to the places mentioned in the supply order at his own cost and shift them in the beneficiaries ISI 8 frame boxes .k) He has to get ISI A type 8 frame Bee boxes with Teak Wood Brood frames as a specimen/sample bee box from the board's Carpentry & Black smithy workshop located at MIDC Gokul Shirgaon, Dist. Kolhapur. Considering the sample f box, bidders have to prepare and supply six frames and honey combs made of teak wood. Since the bee space in the 8 frame honey combs of the Board's bee boxes is 8 mm, the frames and colonies have to be prepared and supplied in such a way that the bees can move easily after shifting in bee boxes of the beneficiaries of the MSKVIB.
- l) The bidder himself has to bear the cost of the empty bee boxes which he used for transportation of bee colonies as well as the cost of shifting the in the board's beneficiaries bee boxes and the cost of returning the empty boxes from the supply site.
- K) After the successful bidder supplies the bee colony to the beneficiary as per the supply order, they will be replaced with six empty teak frames by the board Annexure - 1.

2.2 Payment terms:

- a) The supplied Bee Colonies (*Apis cerana indica*, 6-comb colonies with frames) for distribution to beneficiaries and for setting up of bee nurseries across Maharashtra shall be inspected by the respective team of MSKVIB within 7 days from the date of delivery, and the inspection report shall be submitted within an additional three days.
- b) Payment shall be made through RTGS upon receipt of a satisfactory report from the authorized inspection team of MSKVIB.

2.3 Delivery period:

The delivery of Bee Colonies shall be made to the destinations specified in the Purchase Order. The entire consignment shall be delivered within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of the Supply Order. The delivery shall be completed within the stipulated time from the date of issue of the Supply Order. In the event of any delay in delivery beyond the stipulated period, the CEO, MSKVIB shall have the right to impose a penalty as per applicable rules, and/or cancel the Supply Order, without prejudice to any other rights available under the terms of this Tender Document.

2.4. Other Terms:

- a) The agreement with the successful bidder should be given by the bidder for SUPPLY OF BEE COLONIES APIS CERANA INDICA BEE COLOIES 6 COMBS FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE BENEFICIARIES AND SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ALL OVER MAHARASHTRA.
- b) Termination of contract by successful bidder before completion of contract will result into forfeiture of entire security deposit.
- c) The attested photo copy of GST registration Certificate mentioning details or wherever applicable GST Exemption Certificate from Sales Tax Authority. Proof of GST paid if any should be enclose along with tender. As TAN No & PAN No. Proof

If inspection officer of CEO, MSKVIB finds that bee colonies from any period of the consignment are not fully confirmed to the particulars of the supply, the part of consignment shall be rejected. No payment will be made in such cases.
- i) All government taxes and duties, insurances, income tax and etc. on the supplied material must be paid by successful bidder only.

2.5. SECURITY DEPOSIT

- a) The successful bidder shall have to deposit security Rs 100000/- by way of Bank guarantee in the name of **"Maharashtra State Khadi & Village Industries Board"** payable at Mumbai within 10 days from the issue of letter of acceptance.

- b) Failure to comply with the terms regarding Security Deposit shall entitle CEO,MSKVIB for cancellation of the SUPPLY OF BEE COLONIES APIS CERANA INDICA BEE COLOIES 6 COMBS FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE BENEFICIARIES AND SETTING UP OF BEE NURSERIES ALL OVER MAHARASHTRA EMD shall be forfeited.
- c) The security deposit will remain with CEO, MSKVIB as interest free deposit and will remain with CEO, MSKVIB up to the end of contract period.

2.6. INSURANCE

2.7. FORCE MAJEURE

a) If at any time during continuance of, the performance in whole in part in any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reasons of any war, hostility acts of public enemy, acts of civil commotion, strikes, lockouts, sabotages, fire, flood, explosion, epidemics, quarantine restrictions (hereinafter referred to as eventualities) then, the notice of the happening of any such eventuality, be entitled to terminate this contract, nor, shall have any claim for damages, compensations against the other in respect of such non – performance or delay in performance, and deliveries under this contract. Normal working shall be resumed as soon as such eventuality has come to an end or ceased to exist.

b) Provided that if the performance in whole or in part by the bidder or any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of and such eventuality for a period exceeding 30 (thirty) days, than the CEO, MSKVIB may terminate this contract by giving notice in writing.

2.8. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

The dispute resolution mechanism shall be as follows:
